

Liggett Powers to Victory at 2026 Carolina Open

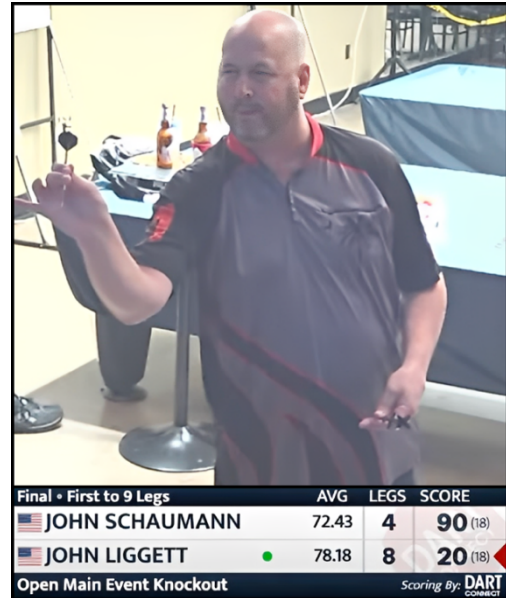
Charleston, SC - March 8, 2026 – John Liggett put on a dominant display of darts this weekend at The Carolina Open, ultimately securing the championship title in the Singles 501 SIDO event. Liggett's consistent play and high scoring proved too much for the field, culminating in a thrilling victory in the final match.

Throughout the tournament, Liggett showcased the skill and composure that have made him a formidable competitor. Starting in the Top 32, he steadily worked his way through the bracket, facing a series of challenging opponents.

His journey began with a commanding performance against Wade Roberts, where he set the tone with a solid 3-dart average (3DA). Liggett continued to build momentum, defeating Wes Lippert and Nick McKinnon in subsequent rounds, demonstrating his ability to maintain focus and execute under pressure.

In the semi-finals, Liggett faced off against Chris Chism in a closely contested match. Despite the pressure, Liggett held his nerve and emerged victorious, earning his spot in the final.

The championship match saw Liggett go head-to-head with John Schaumann. Both players delivered exceptional performances, treating the crowd to a display of high-quality darts. However, Liggett's superior scoring and clinical finishing proved to be the difference maker. He consistently found the big scores, including a maximum 180, and closed out legs with precision, including a high finish (HF) of 96.



Liggett's final 3DA of 73.06, along with his impressive leg win percentage of 74%, highlights the level of consistency he maintained throughout the event. This victory marks a significant achievement for Liggett and solidifies his position as a top-tier player in the darts community.
