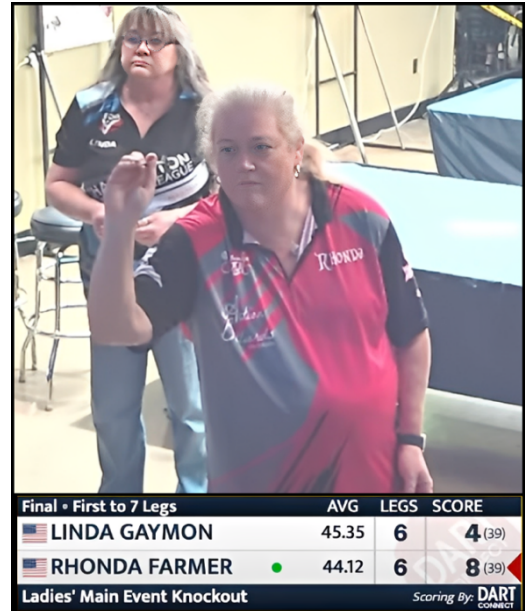


## Rhonda Farmer Crowns Herself Champion at 2026 Carolina Open

**Charleston, SC – March 8, 2026** – Rhonda Farmer etched her name into the history books this weekend, capturing the **Ladies' Singles 501 SIDO** title at the [2026 Carolina Open](#). In a display of grit and tactical precision, Farmer navigated a competitive field to claim the championship in a hard-fought final.

Farmer's road to the title was marked by escalating performance. She opened her knockout campaign in the **Top 8** with a steady win over Melissa McDermott, averaging **36.58**. As the stakes rose, so did Farmer's game; she surged in the **Top 4** semifinals, posting a tournament-best match average of **47.80** to defeat Brooke Masten and secure her place in the final.

While Gaymon entered the final with a slightly higher overall tournament average, Farmer's clinical finishing and consistency in the high-pressure moments allowed her to edge out the victory. Farmer finished the match with a **43.86 average**, narrowly outmaneuvering Gaymon's 45.35 in a contest where every dart counted.

### Tournament Statistics

Farmer's championship run was defined by several standout metrics:

- **Overall 3-Dart Average:** 42.91
- **High Turn (HTurn):** 140
- **Leg Win Percentage:** 63%
